## The Air Quality Standards (Wales) Regulations 2010

## PART 4

National exposure reduction for PM<sub>2.5</sub>

#### Duty of the Welsh Ministers to limit exposure to PM<sub>2.5</sub>

**19.**—(1) The Welsh Ministers must ensure that all necessary measures not entailing disproportionate costs are taken to reduce exposure to  $PM_{2.5}$  with a view to attaining the national exposure reduction target by 2020.

(2) The Welsh Ministers must ensure that all appropriate measures are taken with a view to ensuring that the average exposure indicator for 2015 does not exceed 20  $\mu$ g/m<sup>3</sup>.

(3) In this regulation—

"average exposure indicator" ("*dangosydd cysylltiad cyfartaleddog*") means the indicator for PM<sub>2.5</sub> calculated by the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23 of the Air Quality Standards Regulations 2010<sup>M1</sup>; and

"national exposure reduction target" ("*targed cenedlaethol ar gyfer lleihau cysylltiad*") means the target for  $PM_{2.5}$  established by the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 24 of those Regulations.
