Monitoring

Monitoring authority

- **3.**—(1) [FIThe Natural Resources Body for Wales] is the monitoring authority for the purposes of the targets.
 - (2) The monitoring authority must—
 - (a) monitor the performance of local authorities with respect to the targets:
 - (b) monitor the performance of local authorities in complying with their obligations under these Regulations;
 - (c) in accordance with regulation 7, validate the information that is entered by local authorities on the WasteDataFlow system; and
 - (d) without delay notify the Welsh Ministers, in writing, of any case where it appears to the monitoring authority that a local authority(1) is or may be liable to a penalty under section 3(7) of the Measure or under these Regulations.
