**The A470 Trunk Road (Junction
32, Coryton Interchange, Cardiff)
(40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2011**

Made 28 November 2011

Coming into force 7 December 2011

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 (Cardiff to Llangurig) Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”) in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 84 (1) & (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and after consultation with the Chief Constable of the South Wales Police, make this Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 7 December 2011. The title to this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (Junction 32, Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on those lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of the Coryton Interchange and the segregated lane from the M4 eastbound to the A470 northbound.

- (i) That length of the Coryton Interchange from a point at the nosing of the A470 on slip road to a point 120 metres north of the said point.
- (ii) That length of the segregated lane from a point at the end of the M4 Motorway eastbound exit slip road to the point of entry onto the A470 northbound entry slip road.
