The Marine Licensing (Exempted Activities) (Wales) Order 2011

PART 3

Activities to which article 4 (exemption from need for marine licence) applies, and conditions

Removal of obstruction or danger to navigation

23.—(1) Article 4 applies to a removal activity carried on by a person referred to in paragraph (2) for the purpose of removing anything causing or likely to cause obstruction or danger to navigation.

(2) The persons are—

- (a) a conservancy authority (within the meaning given by section 313(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995⁽¹⁾);
- (b) a harbour authority;
- (c) a lighthouse authority;
- (d) a person having powers under any enactment or statutory order to work or maintain a canal or other inland navigation, including a navigation in tidal water.
