**The Marine Licensing (Civil Sanctions) (Wales) Order 2011**

**PART 2**

Fixed monetary penalties

**Appeals against fixed monetary penalties**

**12.**—(1) The person on whom a fixed monetary penalty is imposed may appeal against the decision to impose it<sup>(1)</sup>.

(2) The grounds of appeal are—

- (a) that the decision was based on an error of fact;
- (b) that the decision was wrong in law;
- (c) that the decision was unreasonable;
- (d) any other reason permitted by the First-tier Tribunal.
