**The Welsh Language (Wales) Measure
2011 (Commencement No.4) Order 2012**

Commencement

2. The following provisions of the Welsh Language (Wales) Measure 2011 come into force on 1 April 2012—

- (a) sections 2, 23, 138, 139 and 146 to the extent that these sections are not already in force;
- (b) Schedules 1, 4 and 12 to the extent these Schedules are not already in force;
- (c) sections 3, 5 and 6;
- (d) section 7 except for
 - (i) subsections (2) and (6) where those subsections relate to Part 5, and
 - (ii) subsections (3)(b), (4), (8) and (10);
- (e) Schedule 2 except for paragraph 8(2)(a);
- (f) sections 8 to 10 and 12 to 15;
- (g) section 16 except for subsections (2)(a) and (b);
- (h) sections 17 to 19;
- (i) Part 4 is commenced as follows:
 - (i) Chapters 2 to 5,
 - (ii) Chapter 8, and
 - (iii) Chapter 9 except for section 69;
- (j) Schedules 5 to 9;
- (k) Part 6;
- (l) paragraphs 9 and 18 of Schedule 11 and section 120(4) in so far as it relates to those paragraphs;
- (m) sections 134 to 137;
- (n) section 140 except for the following:
 - (i) subsection (1)(c), and
 - (ii) subsections (1)(d) and (e) where those subsections refer to investigations under Part 5;
- (o) section 141 except for the following:
 - (i) subparagraph (a) of the definition of “complainant”, and
 - (ii) subparagraph (b) of the definition of “investigation”;
- (p) sections 142, 143, 144(3)(b) and 147.
