The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic
Contraventions (Representations and Appeals)
Removed Vehicles (Wales) Regulations 2013

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“the 1984 Act” (“*Deddf 1984*”) means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“the 2004 Act” (“*Deddf 2004*”) means the Traffic Management Act 2004⁽¹⁾;

“adjudicator” (“*dyfarnydd*”) means an adjudicator appointed under Part 4 of the General Provisions Regulations;

“civil enforcement area” (“*ardal gorfodi sifil*”), “enforcement authority” (“*awdurdod gorfodi*”) and “penalty charge” (“*tâl cosb*”) have the same meanings as in Part 6 of the 2004 Act;

“the General Provisions Regulations” (“*y Rheoliadau Darpariaethau Cyffredinol*”) means the Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (General Provisions) (Wales) Regulations 2013⁽²⁾; and

“the Representations and Appeals Regulations” (“*y Rheoliadau Sylwadau ac Apelau*”) means the Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Representations and Appeals) (Wales) Regulations 2013⁽³⁾.
