The National Health Service (Physiotherapist, Podiatrist or Chiropodist Independent Prescribers) (Miscellaneous Amendments) (Wales) Regulations 2014

Amendment of the 2013 Regulations

- **6.**—(1) The 2013 Regulations are amended in accordance with the following provisions of this regulation.
- (2) In regulation 2(1), in the appropriate place in the alphabetical order insert the following definitions—
 - ""physiotherapist independent prescriber" ("ffisiotherapydd-ragnodydd annibynnol") means a person—
 - (a) who is a physiotherapist, and
 - (b) against whose name in Part 9 of the register maintained under article 5 of the Health and Social Work Professions Order 2011 is recorded an annotation signifying that he or she is qualified to order drugs, medicines and appliances as a physiotherapist independent prescriber;";
 - ""podiatrist or chiropodist independent prescriber" ("podiatrydd-ragnodydd neu giropodydd-ragnodydd annibynnol") means a person—
 - (a) who is a podiatrist or a chiropodist, and
 - (b) against whose name in Part 2 of the register maintained under article 5 of the Health and Social Work Professions Order 2011 is recorded an annotation signifying that he or she is qualified to order drugs, medicines and appliances as a podiatrist or chiropodist independent prescriber;".
 - (3) In regulation 2(1), for the definition of "prescriber" substitute—
 - ""prescriber" ("rhagnodydd") means a doctor, dentist, independent nurse prescriber, nurse independent prescriber, optometrist independent prescriber, pharmacist independent prescriber, physiotherapist independent prescriber, podiatrist or chiropodist independent prescriber or a supplementary prescriber;".
