The Care and Support (Charging) (Wales) Regulations 2015

PART 2

CHARGING UNDER PART 5 OF THE ACT

Persons who may not be charged

- 3.** A local authority may not impose a charge for care and support provided or arranged—
- (a) to meet the needs of a child;
 - (b) for a person who is suffering from any form of Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease where that disease has been clinically diagnosed by a registered medical practitioner⁽¹⁾;
 - (c) for a person who has been offered or is receiving a service provided as part of a package of after care services in accordance with section 117 of the Mental Health Act 1983⁽²⁾ (after care).
