The A4076 Trunk Road (Freemans Way, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016

Made 22 November 2016

Coming into force 27 November 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the length of the Haverfordwest – Milford Haven Trunk Road (A4076) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 27 November 2016 and its title is The A4076 Trunk Road (Freemans Way, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the lengths of the trunk road known as Freemans Way, Haverfordwest in the County of Pembrokeshire that extends from its junction with the southern side of Salutation Square Roundabout to its junction with the eastern side of Merlin's Bridge Roundabout;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 27 November 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
