Mae erthygl 2(2) yn dileu'r rhwymedigaeth ar  
ddiffoddwyr Tân i dalu cyfraniadau ar gyfer y cyfnod ar  
ol iddynt ennill yr hawlogaeth pensiwn mwyaf a  
ganiateir nes iddynt gyrraedd 50 oed, yr oedran isaf ar  
gyfer tynnu allan fuddion. Mae'r newid yn cael effaith  
o 1 Rhagfyr 2006. Mae adran 12 o Ddeddf Blwydd-  
daliadau 1972 yn caniatáu i ddarpariaethau gael effaith  
ol-weithredol.

Mae erthyglau 2(3) a 3 yn darparu bod unrhyw  
gyfraniadau o'r fath a dalwyd rhwng 1 Rhagfyr 2006  
a'r dyddiad y daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym yn cael eu  
had-dalu. Mae'r fformiwl a nodir yn erthygl 3 yn  
ystyried llog a hefyd godiad sy'nadlewyrchu'r dreth a  
fydd yn daladwy o dan Ddeddf Cyllid 2004. O dan  
erthygl 2(3) gwneir taliadau o'r Gronfa Bensiwn y  
Diffoddwyr Tân berthnasol y mae'n ofynnol i bob  
awdurdod Tân ac achub ei sefydlu a'i chynnal at  
ddibenion y Cynllun.

Ystyriwyd Cod Ymarfer Gweinidogion Cymru ar

The Firefighters' Pension (Wales)  
Scheme (Amendment and

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(*This note is not part of the Order*)

This Order amends the Firefighters' Pension (Wales)  
Scheme (set out in Schedule 2 to the Firemen's  
Pension Scheme Order 1992 as it has effect in Wales)  
("the Scheme").

Article 2(2) removes the obligation on firefighters to  
pay contributions for the period after they have  
reckoned the maximum permissible pension  
entitlement until they reach age 50, the minimum age  
to draw benefits. The change takes effect from 1  
December 2006. Section 12 of the Superannuation Act  
1972 permits provisions to have retrospective effect.

Articles 2(3) and 3 make provision for the repayment  
of any such contributions paid between 1 December  
2006 and the date this Order comes into force. The  
formula set out in article 3 takes account of both  
interest and an uplift reflecting the tax charge that will  
be payable under the Finance Act 2004. Under article  
2(3), payments will be made from the relevant  
Firefighters' Pension Fund which each fire and rescue  
authority is required to establish and maintain for the  
purposes of the Scheme.

The Welsh Ministers' Regulatory Impact  
Assessment Code for Subordinate Legislation has been  
considered in relation to this Order. As a result, it was  
not considered necessary to carry out a regulatory  
impact assessment as to the likely costs and benefits of  
complying with this Order.

1.—(1) Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Cynllun Pensiwn y Dynion Tân (Cymru) (Diwygio a Darpariaethau Trosiannol) 2016.

(2) Daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar 31 Rhagfyr 2016 ond mae erthygl 2(2) yn cael effaith o 1 Rhagfyr 2006(3).

## Diwygio Gorchymyn Cynllun Pensiwn y Dynion Tân 1992

2.—(1) Mae Atodlen 2 i Orchymyn Cynllun Pensiwn y Dynion Tân 1992(4) (lle y mae Cynllun Pensiwn y Dynion Tân (Cymru) wedi ei nodi), wedi ei diwygio fel a ganlyn.

(2) Yn rheol G2 (cyfraniadau pensiwn)(5)—

- (a) ym mharagraff (1) yn lle “A regular firefighter shall” rhodder “Subject to paragraph (1B), a regular firefighter shall”; a
- (b) cyn paragraff (2) mewnosoder—

“(1B) Paragraph (1) does not apply to a firefighter below the age of 50 who has reckoned 30 years or more pensionable service.”

applied by section 16(3)(1) of that Act, and now vested in them(2), make the following Order.

## Title and commencement

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Firefighters' Pension (Wales) Scheme (Amendment and Transitional Provisions) Order 2016.

(2) This Order comes into force on 31 December 2016 but article 2(2) has effect from 1 December 2006(3).

## Amendment of the Firemen's Pension Scheme Order 1992

2.—(1) Schedule 2 to the Firemen's Pension Scheme Order 1992(4) (in which is set out the Firefighters' Pension (Wales) Scheme) is amended as follows.

(2) In rule G2 (pension contributions)(5)—

- (a) in paragraph (1) for “A regular firefighter shall” substitute “Subject to paragraph (1B), a regular firefighter shall”; and
- (b) before paragraph (2) insert—

“(1B) Paragraph (1) does not apply to a firefighter below the age of 50 who has reckoned 30 years or more pensionable service.”

(2) For the purposes of the Firefighters' Pension (Wales) Scheme, section 26(1) to (5) have effect as if for each reference to the “Secretary of State” there were substituted a reference to the “National Assembly for Wales”; see article 2 of S.I. 2006/1672 (W. 160). By virtue of paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32) the Assembly's functions under section 26 of the Fire Services Act 1947 are now vested in the Welsh Ministers so far as they are exercisable in relation to Wales.

(3) Power to give retrospective effect is conferred by section 12(1) of the Superannuation Act 1972 (c. 11).

3.—(1) Rhaid i awdurdod Tân ac achub dalu'r swm gofynnol fel y'i disgrifir ym mharagraff (3) i ddiffoddwr Tân sy'n dod o fewn paragraff (2).

(2) Mae diffoddwr Tân yn dod o fewn y paragraff hwn os talodd y diffoddwr Tân gyfraniadau pensiwn yn y cyfnod sy'n dechrau ar 1 Rhagfyr 2006 ac yn gorffen ar 31 Rhagfyr 2016 yn unol â rheol G2(1) o Gynllun Pensiwn y Dnyon Tân (Cymru) nad oeddynt yn daladwy o ganlyniad i erthygl 2(2) o'r Gorchymyn hwn.

(3) Y swm gofynnol yw cyfandaliad sy'n hafal i  $(A + B) \times C$ , pan—

A yw cyfanswm pob cyfraniad a dalwyd net unrhyw dreth a fyddai'n daladwy gan y diffoddwr Tân pe na bai'r cyfraniad wedi ei dalu;

B yw'r llog ar A a gyfrifir yn unol â pharagraff (4); ac

C yw 100/60.

(4) O ran llog—

- (a) rhaid ei gyfrifo ar wahân mewn perthynas â phob cyfraniad a delir; a
- (b) rhaid ei gymhwys o'n adlog ar sail y gyfradd log flaenorol o ddydd i ddydd ar gyfer y cyfnod a bennir ym mharagraff (5).

(5) Mae'r cyfnod a bennir at ddibenion paragraff (4)(b) yn dechrau ar ddiwrnod cyntaf y mis y talwyd pob cyfraniad ynddo ac mae'n dod i ben ar ddiwrnod olaf y mis cyn y mis y telir y cyfanswm gofynnol ynddo.

(6) Pan fo taliad yn ofynnol o dan baragraff (1) mewn cysylltiad â diffoddwr Tân a fu farw cyn 31 Rhagfyr 2016 neu sy'n marw ar y dyddiad hwnnw neu wedyn ond cyn i'r taliad gael ei wneud, rhaid i'r awdurdod Tân ac achub dalu'r swm dyledus i glynrychiolwyr personol y diffoddwr Tân.

(7) At ddibenion yr erthygl hon—

(3) In rule LA1(3) (establishment, maintenance and operation of Firefighters' Pension Fund, etc.)(1)—

- (a) at the end of sub-paragraph (d) for “.” substitute “; and”; and
- (b) after sub-paragraph (d) insert—
  - “(e) sums payable under article 3 of the Firefighters’ Pension (Wales) Scheme (Amendment and Transitional Provisions) Order 2016.”

## Transitional provision

3.—(1) A fire and rescue authority must pay the required amount as described in paragraph (3) to a firefighter who falls within paragraph (2).

(2) A firefighter falls within this paragraph if in the period beginning on 1 December 2006 and ending on 31 December 2016 the firefighter paid pensions contributions pursuant to rule G2(1) of the Firefighters’ Pension (Wales) Scheme which as a consequence of article 2(2) of this Order did not fall to be payable.

(3) The required amount is a lump sum equal to  $(A + B) \times C$ , where—

A is the total value of each contribution paid net of any tax that would have been payable by the firefighter had the contribution not been paid;

B is the interest on A calculated in accordance with paragraph (4); and

C is 100/60.

(4) Interest must be—

- (a) calculated separately in relation to each contribution paid; and
- (b) applied on a compound basis at the past interest rate on a day to day basis for the period specified in paragraph (5).

(5) The period specified for the purposes of paragraph (4)(b) begins on the first day of the month in which each contribution was paid and ends on the last day of the month before the month in which the payment of the required amount is made.

(6) Where a payment is required to be made under paragraph (1) in respect of a firefighter who died before 31 December 2016 or who dies on or after that date but before the payment is made, the fire and rescue authority must pay the sum due to the firefighter's personal representatives.

ystyr “cyfradd sylfaenol Banc Lloegr” (“*Bank of England base rate*”) yw—

- (a) y gyfradd a gyhoeddir o bryd i’w gilydd gan Bwyllgor Polisi Ariannol Banc Lloegr fel y gyfradd fasnachu swyddogol, sef y gyfradd y mae’r Banc yn fodlon ei defnyddio mewn trafodiadau i ddarparu hylifedd byrdymor yn y marchnadoedd arian; neu
- (b) pan fo gorchymyn mewn grym o dan adran 19 (pwerau wrth gefn) o Ddeddf Banc Lloegr 1998(2), unrhyw gyfradd gyfwerth a bennir gan y Trysorlys o dan yr honno.

“Bank of England base rate” (“*cyfradd sylfaenol Banc Lloegr*”) means—

- (a) the rate announced from time to time by the Monetary Policy Committee of the Bank of England as the official dealing rate, being the rate at which the Bank is willing to enter into transactions for providing short term liquidity in the money markets; or
- (b) where an order under section 19 (reserve powers) of the Bank of England Act 1998(1) is in force, any equivalent rate determined by the Treasury under that section;

“fire and rescue authority” (“*awdurdod Tân ac achub*”) has the same meaning as in the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004(2); and

“past interest rate” (“*cyfradd log flaenorol*”) is a rate equivalent to the Bank of England base rate applicable on each day of the period specified in paragraph (5).
