**The Size and Composition of Local Planning  
Authority Committees (Wales) Regulations 2017**

**Interpretation**

**2.** In these Regulations—

“the 1990 Act” (“*Deddf 1990*”) means the Town and Country Planning Act 1990;

“committee” (“*pwyllogor*”) includes a sub-committee of a relevant authority;

“electoral ward” (“*ward etholiadol*”) means any area for which members are elected to a local authority;

“local authority” (“*awdurdod lleol*”) means —

- (a) a county council in Wales;
- (b) a county borough council in Wales;

“multiple member ward<sup>(1)</sup>” (“*ward amlaelod*”) means an electoral ward in respect of which more than one member is elected for that ward; and

“relevant authority” (“*awdurdod perthnasol*”) means a relevant local planning authority<sup>(2)</sup>.
