    - (i) the fee payable in respect of a single plant, plant product or other object of any of the descriptions in question; or
    - (ii) where different amounts are specified in relation to those plants, plant products or other objects, a fee equal to the highest of the fees relating to liability to a physical check or identity check (as the case may be).]

### Payment of fees

10. Fees payable under these Regulations are payable to the Welsh Ministers on demand.

#### Suspension of registration

- 11.—(1) Where any sum due by way of, or on account of, any fee or any part of a fee payable by a [F42 registered professional operator] under Part 2 of these Regulations remains unpaid, the Welsh Ministers may—
  - (a) recover the sum as a civil debt, or
  - (b) after giving one month's written notice, suspend the [F43 operator's] registration until such sum has been paid.
