The Animal By-Products and Pet Passport (Fees) (Wales) Regulations 2018

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

"approval" ("cymeradwyaeth" and "cymeradwyo") includes a conditional approval under Article 44(2) of the EU Control Regulation;

"EU Control Regulation" ("Rheoliad Rheolaeth yr UE") means Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and repealing Regulation (EC) No. 1774/2002(1);

[FI"Official Controls Regulation" ("Rheoliad Rheolaethau Swyddogol") means Regulation (EU) 2017/625 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 March 2017 on official controls and other official activities performed to ensure the application of food and feed law, rules on animal health and welfare, plant health and plant protection products;]

"veterinary officer" ("swyddog milfeddygol") means a veterinary surgeon employed by the Welsh Ministers;

"veterinary surgeon" ("milfeddyg") means a person registered in the register of veterinary surgeons kept under the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966(2).
