

The Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 2018

The Welsh Ministers are designated ^{M1} for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 ^{M2} in relation to the quality of water intended for domestic purposes or for use in a food production undertaking.

The Welsh Ministers make these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 and sections 67, 69, 77(3) and (4) and 213(2) of the Water Industry Act 1991^{M3}.

References to "licensed water suppliers" or the singular term in Schedule 1 to the 1999 Order now read "water supply licensees" or the singular term following the amendments in paragraph 127 of Schedule 7 to the Water Act 2014 ("the 2014 Act"); there are other amending instruments but none are relevant. By virtue of section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006, the functions conferred on the Assembly are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers. Section 69 of the Act was amended by paragraph 19 of Schedule 8, and Part 3 of Schedule 9, to the 2003 Act, and paragraph 68 of Schedule 7 to the 2014 Act. Section 213 of the Act was amended by paragraph 28 of Schedule 1 to the Competition and Service (Utilities) Act 1992 (c. 43) and by section 56 of, and paragraph 119(4) of Schedule 7 to the 2014 Act.
