PART 7

Requirements on service providers -safeguarding

Interpretation of Part 7

26. In this Part—

"abuse" ("camdriniaeth") means physical, sexual, psychological, emotional or financial abuse.

"financial abuse" ("camdriniaeth ariannol") includes—

- (a) having money or other property stolen;
- (b) being defrauded;
- (c) being put under pressure in relation to money or other property;
- (d) having money or other property misused;

"harm" ("niwed") means abuse or the impairment of—

- (a) physical or mental health, or
- (b) physical, intellectual, emotional, social or behavioural development;

"improper treatment" ("triniaeth amhriodol") includes discrimination or unlawful restraint, including inappropriate deprivation of liberty under the terms of the Mental Capacity Act 2005 MI.

"neglect" ("esgeulustod") has the same meaning as in section 197(1) of the 2014 Act.
