CHAPTER 1

Requirement to isolate etc. where person tests positive  
for coronavirus or has close contact with such person

**Withdrawing a notice which requires isolation**

**13.**—(1) This regulation applies where a contact tracer—

- (a) has given a notification under regulation 6(1), 7(1), [F1 or 8(1)] (“the original notification”), but
  - (b) subsequently notifies the recipient of the original notification that it is withdrawn.
- (2) The original notification is treated as if it had not been given.
