PART 2

Restrictions on organising events

Prohibition on organising events

4.—^{F1}^{F2}(1) No person may, without a reasonable excuse, be involved in organising an event ^{F3}held to any extent indoors.]

(1A) For the purposes of this paragraph, a person working, or providing voluntary services, in relation to the holding of an event is not to be treated as attending the event.]

^{F4}(2) Sub-paragraph (1) does not apply to a person involved in organising—

- (a) an event held at a private dwelling at which people do not participate in a gathering in contravention of ^{F5}regulation 37(2)];
- (b) an event authorised by the Welsh Ministers under paragraph 5;
- (c) a solemnisation of a marriage, formation of a civil partnership or an alternative wedding ceremony;
- (d) a funeral;
- (e) ^{F6}a gathering at regulated premises], to—
 - (i) celebrate a solemnisation of a marriage, formation of a civil partnership or alternative wedding ceremony that took place on or after ^{F7}1 December 2021];
 - (ii) celebrate the life of a deceased person whose funeral is held on or after ^{F8}1 December 2021];
- (f) a regulated gathering that takes place to any extent indoors and at which—
 - (i) no more than 30 people are in attendance, ^{F9}... and
 - (ii) no alcohol is consumed;
- ^{F10}(g)
- (h) a regulated gathering ^{F11}... for the development or well-being of children (including sports, music and other recreational activities such as those provided for children outside of school hours and during school holidays).
- ^{F12}(i) an event that is held at regulated premises, other than at holiday or travel accommodation, and at which—
 - (i) no more than 6 people are in attendance, or
 - (ii) all of the people in attendance are members of the same household;
- (j) an event that is any of the following, where it is held in premises ordinarily used for that purpose—
 - (i) the showing of a film,
 - (ii) an entertainment performance where no more than 200 people are in attendance ^{F13}...,
 - (iii) a market, or
 - (iv) a religious service;

- (k) an elite sporting event at which the only people present are elite athletes and persons working or providing voluntary services for the event;

[^{F16}(2A) In determining, for the purposes of sub-paragraph (2), the number of persons in attendance at an event, no account is to be taken of—

- (a) any children under the age of 11,
- (b) the carer of any person in attendance, or
- (c) any person working, or providing voluntary services, at the event.]

(3) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (1)—

- (a) a person is not involved in organising an event if the person's only involvement is attending it;
