The Welsh Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 78 of the Coronavirus Act 2020 ^{M1}, sections 20 and 190 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 ^{M2}, and sections 22 ^{M3} and 105 of the Local Government Act 2000 ^{M4}.
