**The Common Agricultural Policy (Payments to Farmers) (Coronavirus) (Wales) Regulations 2020**

**Amendment of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 809/2014**

2. For the purposes of claim year 2020, the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 809/2014 of 17 July 2014 laying down rules for the application of Regulation (EU) No. 1306/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the integrated administration and control system, rural development measures and cross compliance<sup>(1)</sup> applies as if—

- (a) in Article 13(1), for “15 May each year” there were substituted “15 June 2020”;
- (b) in Article 15(2), for “31 May of the year concerned” there were substituted “30 June 2020”;
- (c) in Article 22(1), for “15 May of the relevant calendar year” there were substituted “15 June 2020”.

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 809/2014 has been amended by regulation 14 of the Financing, Management and Monitoring of Direct Payments to Farmers (Amendment) Regulations 2020 (S.I. 2020/90). There are other amending instruments but none are relevant.
