The Welsh Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 90(2) of the Coronavirus Act 2020⁽¹⁾.

(1) 2020 c. 7. The power to make regulations under section 90(2) of the Act is conferred on “a relevant national authority”. Under section 90(7) of the Act, the Welsh Ministers are a relevant national authority in relation to the power to extend the expiry date of a provision of the Act that extends to England and Wales and applies in relation to Wales, and which would be within the legislative competence of Senedd Cymru if it were contained in an Act of Senedd Cymru (including any provision that could only be made with the consent of a Minister of the Crown within the meaning of the Ministers of the Crown Act 1975).
