**The A5 Trunk Road (Llangollen
and Corwen, Denbighshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Waiting,
Loading & Unloading) Order 2022**

Made 19 April 2022

Coming into force 25 April 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A5 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public arising from the transportation of abnormal indivisible loads.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A5 Trunk Road (Llangollen and Corwen, Denbighshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting, Loading & Unloading) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 25 April 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in

connection with the transportation of the abnormal indivisible loads giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A5 London to Holyhead trunk road;

“transportation period” (“*cyfnod y cludo*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 00:01 hours on 25 April 2022 and ending when all movement of the abnormal indivisible loads has been completed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload during the transportation period on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

The lengths of both sides of the trunk road known as Berwyn Road, Llangollen, Denbighshire that extends westwards from a point 43 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Market Street for a distance of 215 metres.

The southern side of the length of the trunk road known as London Road, Corwen, Denbighshire that extends from a point 27 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with the lane leading to Brookside Cottages to a point 50 metres west of that junction.

The southern side of the length of the trunk road known as London Road, Corwen, Denbighshire that extends from a point 95 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with the lane leading to Brookside Cottages to a point 128 metres west of that junction.

The southern side of the length of the trunk road known as Bridge Street, Corwen, Denbighshire that extends from a point 138 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Green Lane to a point 197 metres west of that junction.
