Consequential Amendments

The Education (School Development Plans) (Wales) Regulations 2014

14.—(1) The Education (School Development Plans) (Wales) Regulations 2014(1) are amended as follows.

(2) On 1 September 2022—

(a) in regulation 2(1)—

(i) for the definition of “national priorities” substitute the following—

““national priorities” (“*blaenoriaethau cenedlaethol*”) are—

(a) improving pupils’ progression by ensuring their learning is supported by a range of knowledge, skills and experience;

(b) reducing the impact of poverty on pupils’ progression and attainment;”,

(ii) omit the definition of “attainment results”, and

(iii) omit the definition of “school comparative information”; and

(b) omit regulation 8.
