Consequential Amendments

The Education (National Curriculum) (Modern Foreign Languages) (Wales) Order 2008

5.—(1) The Education (National Curriculum) (Modern Foreign Languages) (Wales) Order 2008(1) (“the 2008 Order”) applies as follows.

(2) On 1 September 2022, the 2008 Order does not apply to pupils in year 7 at a maintained school where the head teacher and governing body have adopted a relevant curriculum for those year 7 pupils under Part 2 of the 2021 Act.

(3) From 1 September 2023, the 2008 Order does not apply to pupils in years 7 or 8 at a maintained school.

(4) The 2008 Order is revoked on 1 September 2024.
