**The Additional Learning Needs and Education  
Tribunal (Wales) Act 2018 (Commencement No. 13  
and Transitional and Saving Provisions) Order 2022**

**10.**—(1) This article applies to a child who on 1 September 2023 has identified special educational needs and who did not come within article 9 [<sup>F1</sup>or 9A].

(2) Unless the new law applies in relation to the child, the governing body which provides the special educational provision to the child must either give an IDP notice or a No IDP notice to the child and the child’s parent during the 2023-2024 school year [<sup>F2</sup>or the 2024-2025 school year] .
