**Saving provision**

4. Subject to articles 9 to 11 and articles 13 to 18, despite the disapplication by section 96 and paragraph 4(9) of the Schedule to the Act of Chapter 1 of Part 4 of the 1996 Act<sup>(1)</sup> in relation to a child who has identified special educational needs—

- (a) the old law continues to have effect in relation to that child; and
- (b) the new law does not have effect in relation to that child.
