**The Additional Learning Needs and Education
Tribunal (Wales) Act 2018 (Commencement No. 14
and Transitional and Saving Provisions) Order 2022**

[^{F1}9A.—(1) This article applies to a child who on 1 September 2023 has identified special educational needs and who is in year 6 or in year 10 during the 2023-2024 school year or would be in either of those year groups if the child were a registered pupil at a maintained school.

(2) Unless the new law applies in relation to the child, the appropriate local authority must either give an IDP notice or a No IDP notice to the child and the child's parent during the 2023-2024 school year.]
