**The Glyn Rhonwy Pumped Storage Generating  
Station (Amendment) (Wales) Order 2024**

*Made* - - - - 31 January 2024  
*Coming into force* - - 2 February 2024

An application has been made, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 6 to the Planning Act 2008<sup>(1)</sup>, to the Welsh Ministers in accordance with the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011<sup>(2)</sup> for a non-material change to the Glyn Rhonwy Pumped Storage Generating Station Order 2017<sup>(3)</sup>.

The Welsh Ministers have had regard to the effect of the change on the Glyn Rhonwy Pumped Storage Generating Station Order 2017 as amended and are satisfied that the change is not material.

The Welsh Ministers, having considered the application, the responses to the publicity and consultation required by regulations 6 and 7 of the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011, have decided to make the change proposed in the application.

Accordingly, the Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 2(1) and (9) of Schedule 6 to the Planning Act 2008, make the following Order.
