ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A477 Trunk Road (St Clears, Carmarthenshire to Kilgetty, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024

Made 1 July 2024

Coming into force 8 July 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A477 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A477 Trunk Road (St Clears, Carmarthenshire to Kilgetty, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 8 July 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the St Clears to Pembroke Dock trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 20:00 hours on 8 July 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the western side of St Clears Roundabout, Carmarthenshire to its junction with the eastern side of Kilgetty Roundabout, Pembrokeshire.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
